Today we will be learning about **prepositions**.

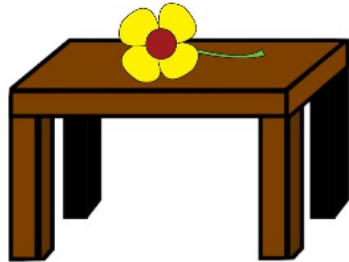
A **preposition** is a word that identifies a **position**. (**Where something is**)

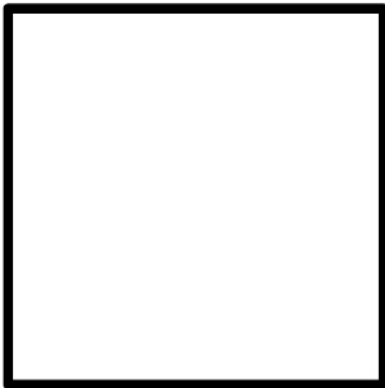

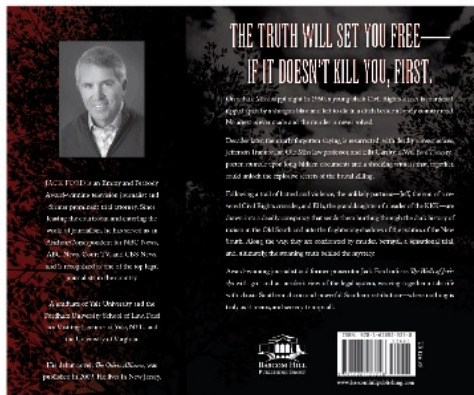

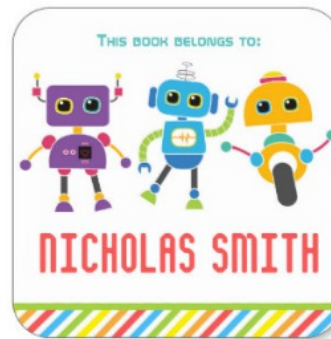

The water rose **to** 2m

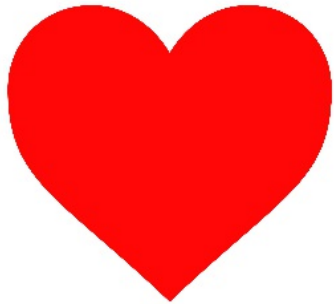

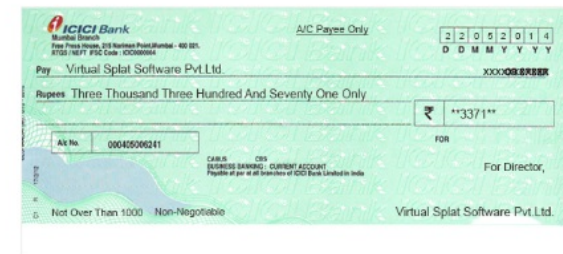
