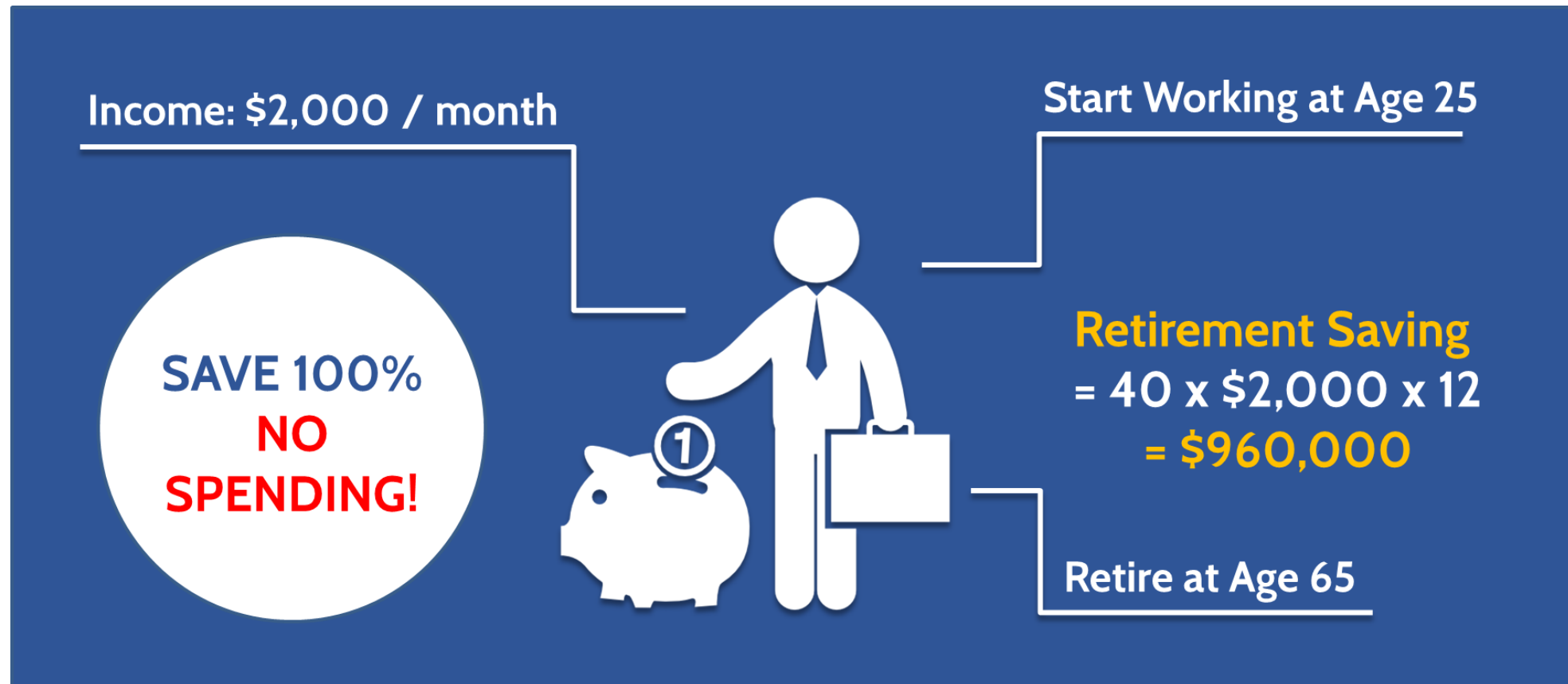
My Two Biggest Mistakes

My Three Best Lessons For You!

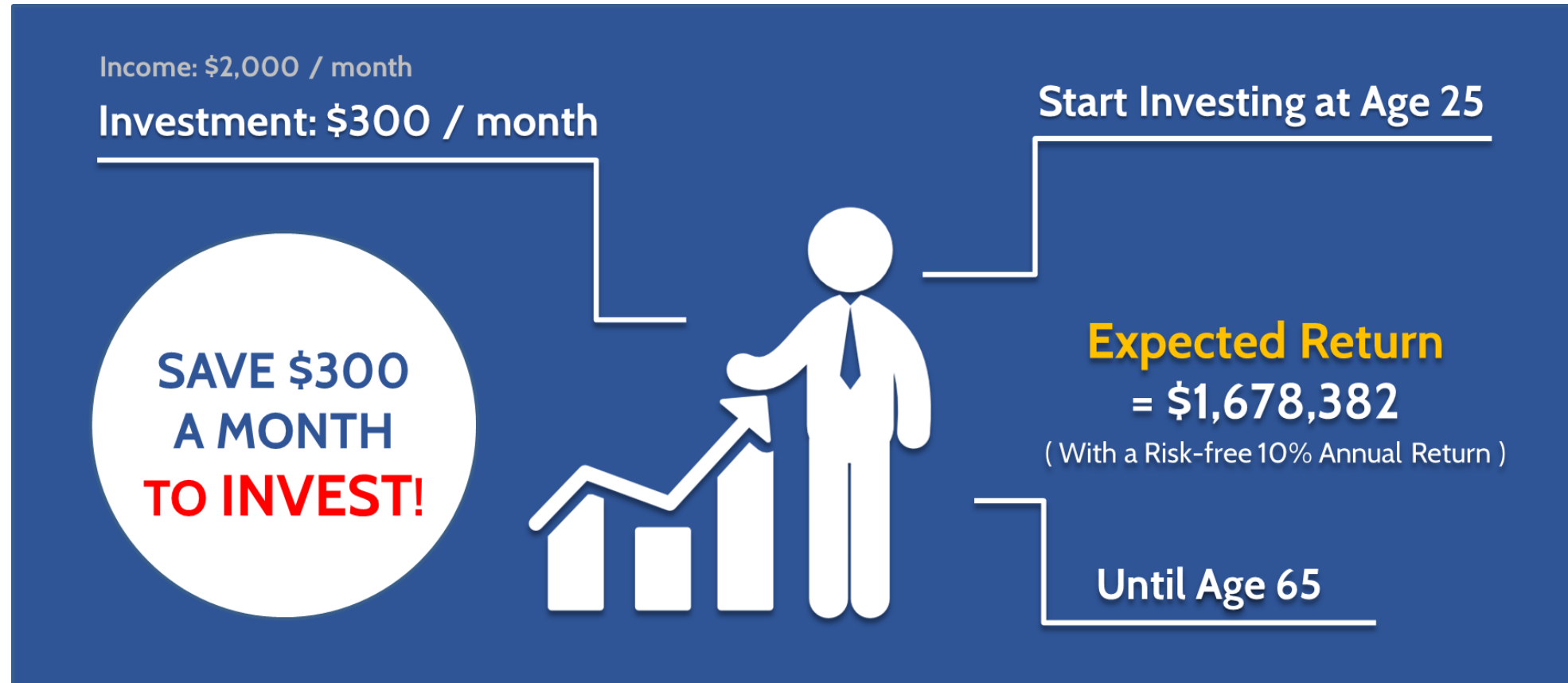

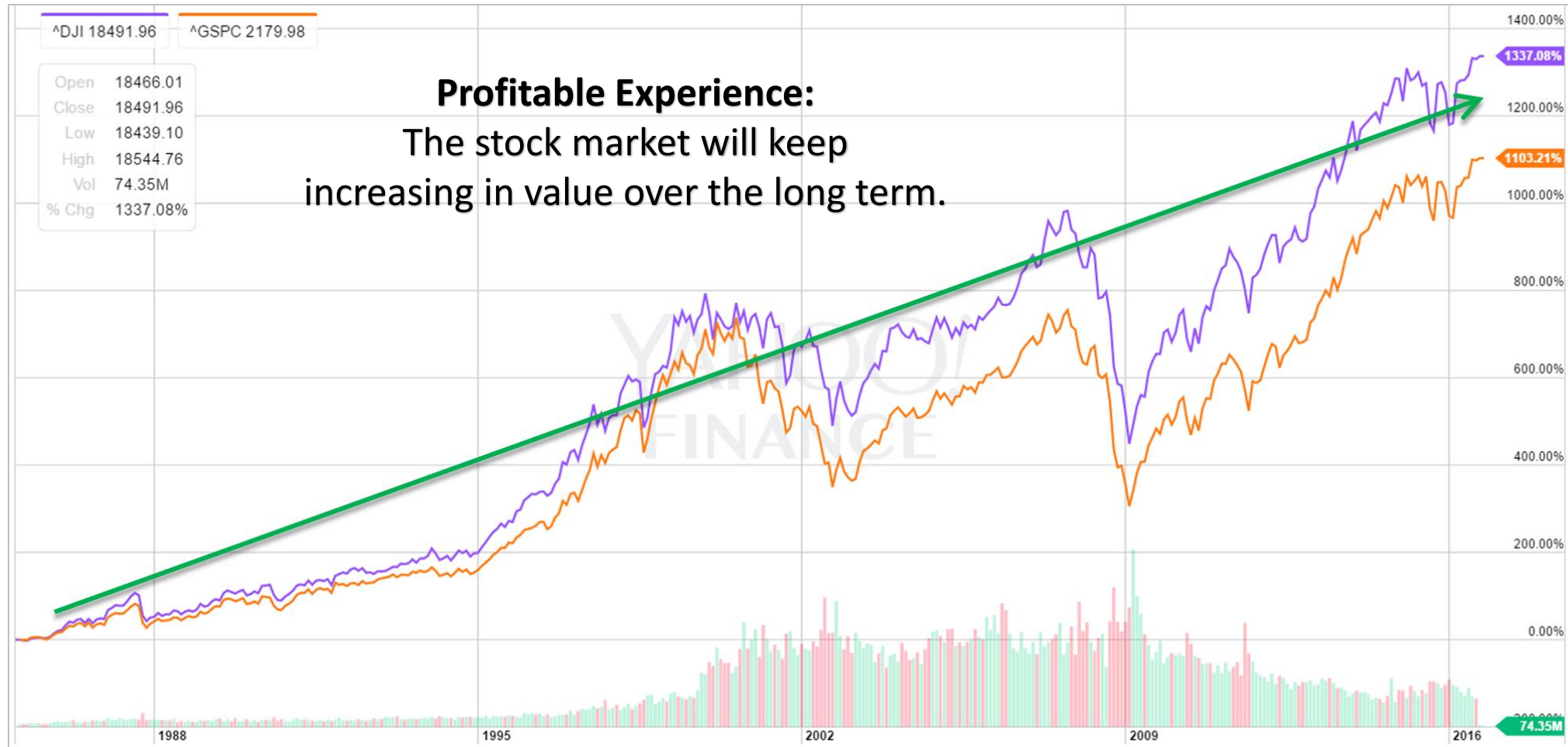

30-Year History of The US Stock Market



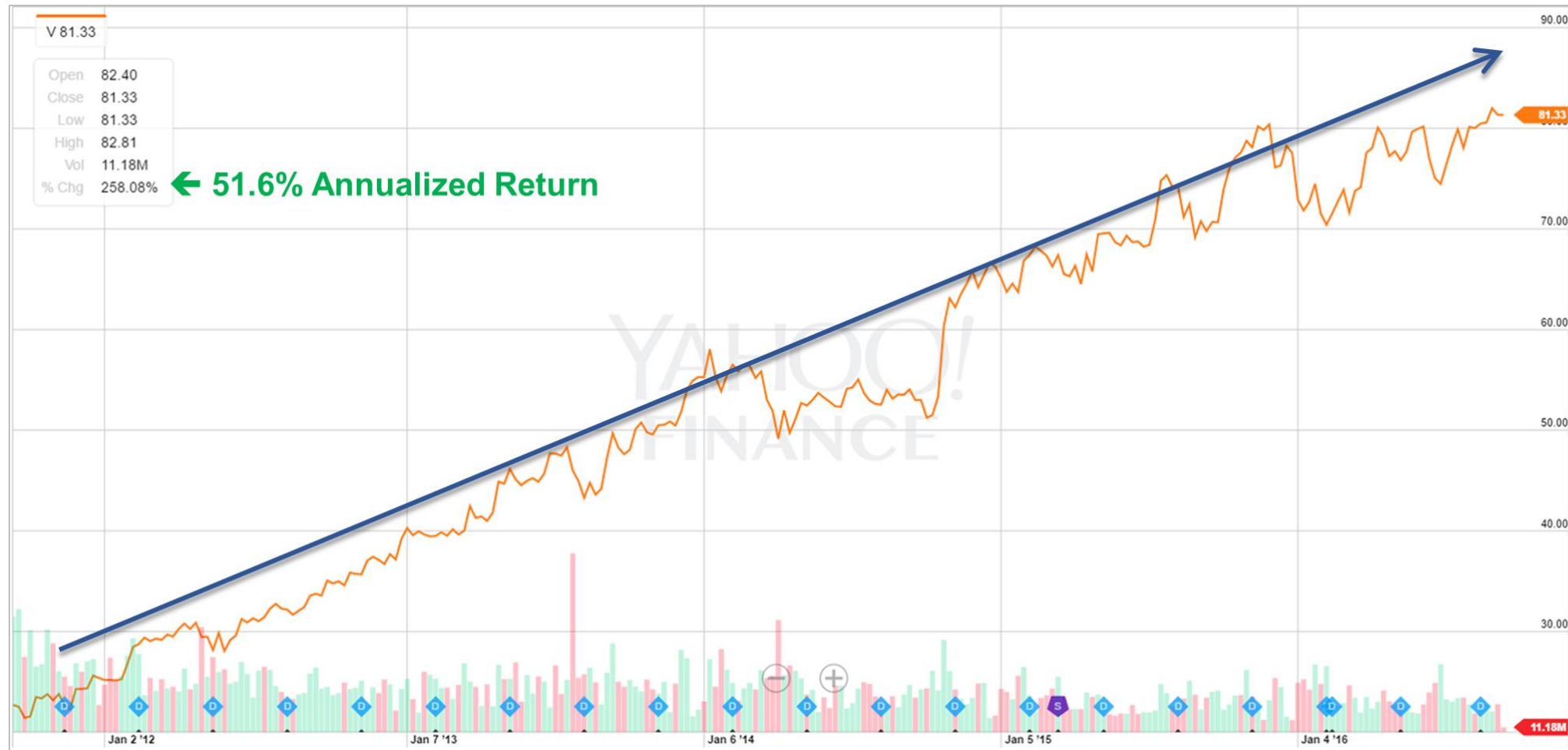
5-Year Performance of The US Stock Market

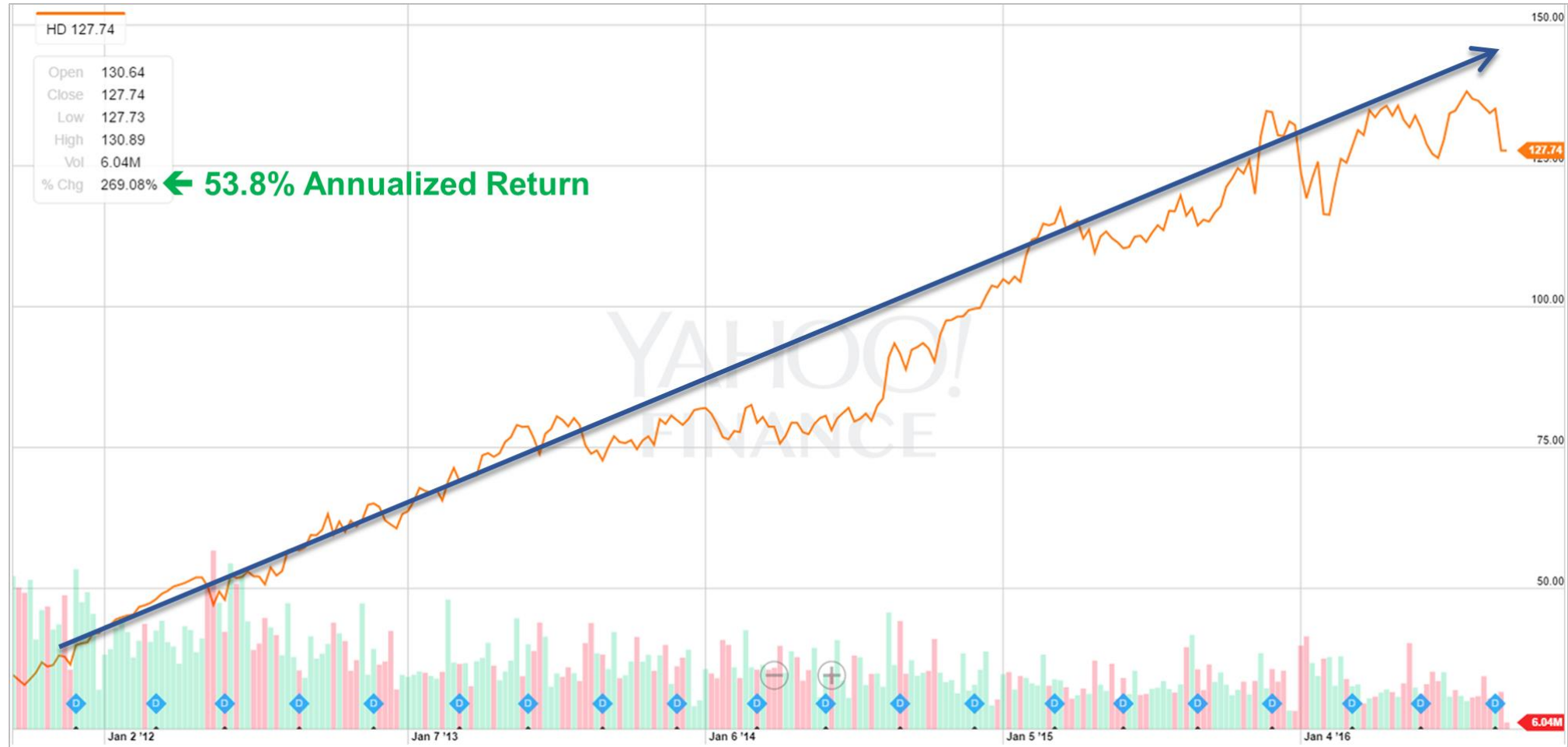

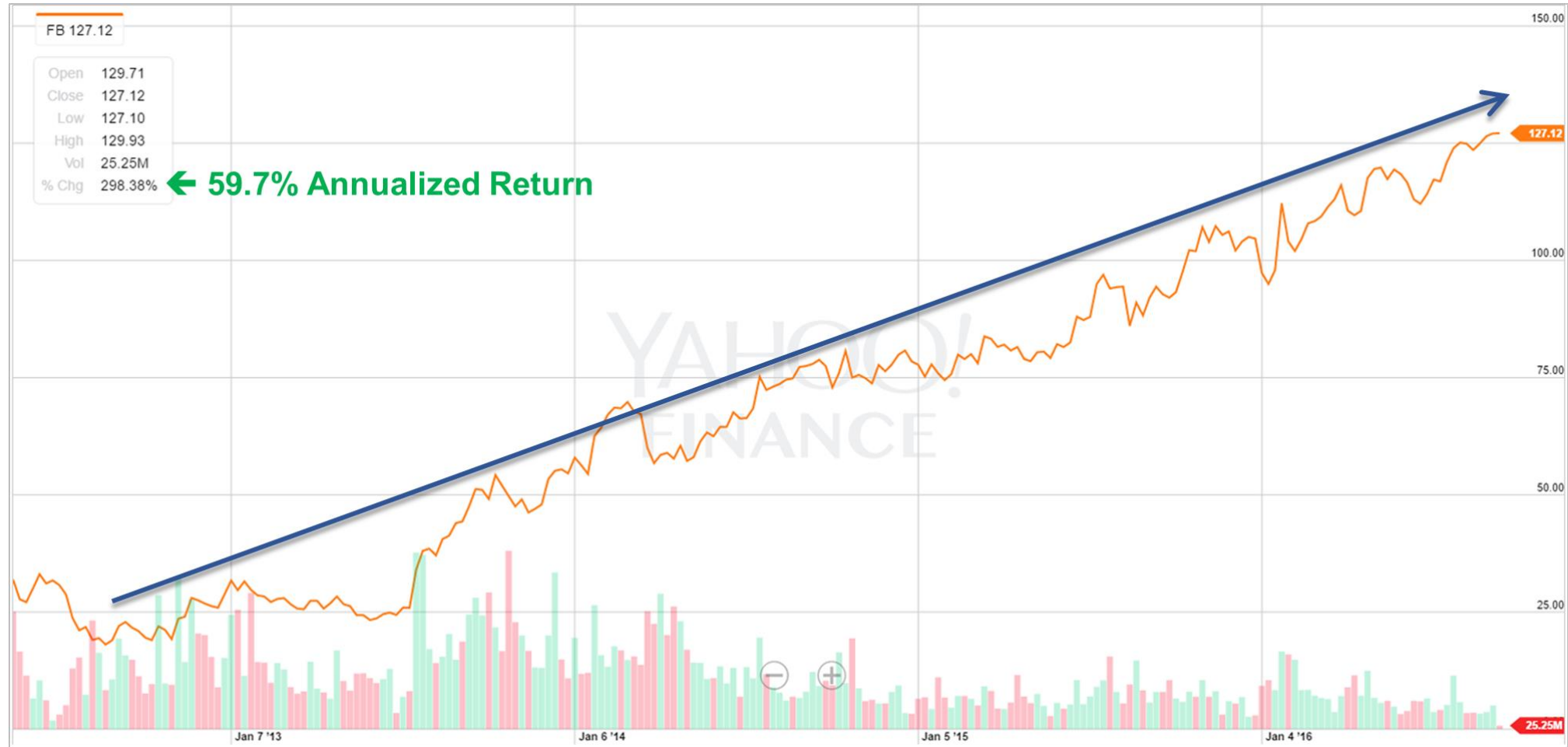

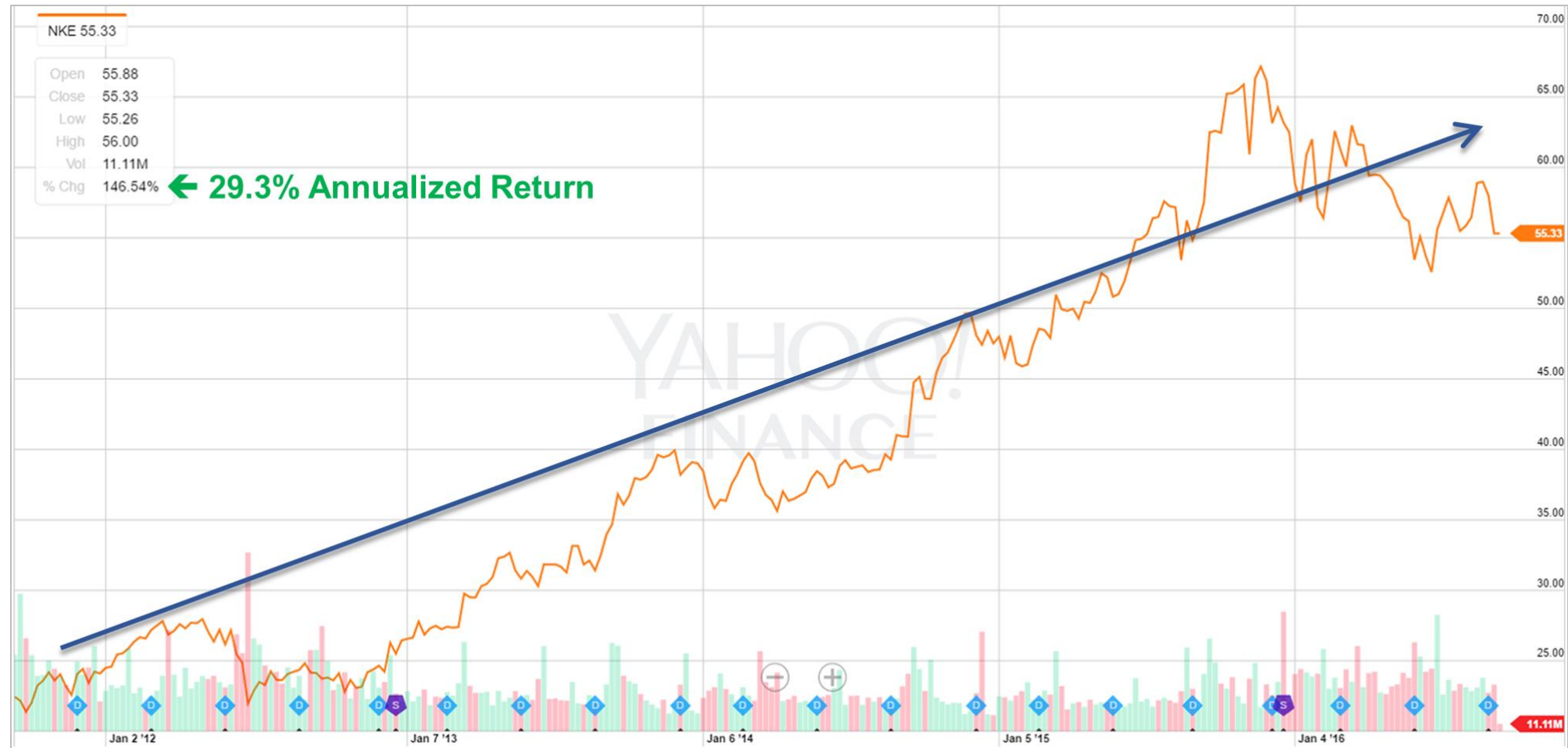
