



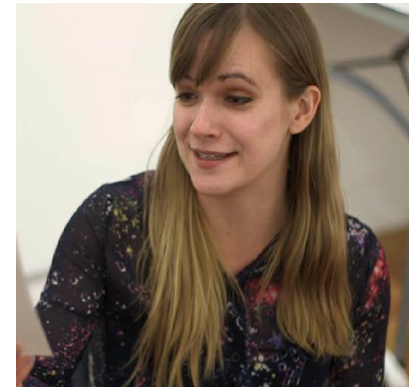

- ⚡ Would like to inform all related professionals in the area (like vets, pet store owners, trainers...)

Joanne has searched using her car and walking, and has recruited friends and neighbors. She has even hung posters when the time stretched out. She also had a microchip implanted in Sammy, but that hasn't been effective at all.

Needs/Goals

- Monitor Sammy's location
- Discover when she escapes immediately
- Locate her quickly

Some people assume Troy is an aggressive dog and tend to be afraid of him. So keeping him contained is important to Curt. He works long and late hours. He keeps Troy outside on a runner with a nice doghouse and has installed an underground electric fence. But Troy breaks the runner and the fence malfunctions. He has had Troy for over 5 years, got him as a puppy, and wouldn't want to be without him.

Needs/Goals

- Better confinement
- Locate Troy quickly
- Utilize a friend to help while he works without burdening him/her



Sheri A.

"Jewel is my life! If she were taken I wouldn't know what to do!"

- 76-year-old woman
- Owns a Ragdoll cat named Jewel
- Lives in a nice apartment in Boston
- Is retired
- Has a smart phone and laptop to keep in touch with her 4 children and 9 grandchildren

Sheri has a friend who lives in the same building who had her cat stolen a year ago. Since then Sheri has had surveillance cameras installed in her apartment which can send a signal to her smart phone if there is an intruder. She occasionally has friends and acquaintances over.

"As a new mom, I try to be diligent about keeping my dog leashed and trained when we go out for walks. Living next to a major, high-traffic road can be scary for runaway pets."

Kim lives in the city and is a mom to a 7-month old baby girl. She is also a mom to a high-energy 10-year-old jack russell terrier who terrorizes squirrels and other critters when they go out for walks. Prior to giving birth to her baby, her dog ran away and she immediately searched the neighborhood and posted his photo on a community Facebook page. He was found less than an hour later by another pet owner a few blocks away. She can't imagine being able to search her neighborhood right away if her dog takes off while she's with her baby. Kim's dog has a microchip but is concerned that anyone who may find her dog are not aware of how it works.

Kim's Goals

- Wants to pay it forward; She wants to be notified immediately of missing/found neighborhood pets so she can help when possible.
- Wants to be able to locate her dog as soon as possible, especially in an urban/high traffic neighborhood.
- Wants to use the device on occasion for her daughter.

ALEX JETSON

PR Manager
46 years old
Lives in the suburbs
In a relationship but lives alone, 2 dogs

"I never had to worry about my dogs running around my fenced yard until I accidentally left the fence gate opened. Try finding two high-energy labradors around the neighborhood at night."

Alex is a busy professional who has two labradors. Since he has a big yard for them to run around in, he only takes them out for long walks on the weekends when he's off from work. His dogs ran around the yard with no leash or tags. One evening, his dogs ran out of his yard through an open gate without him realizing for about 15 minutes. He had to search for them around the neighborhood on his own for several hours. A frustrating and stressful situation. The following week, he had them microchipped and are always wearing tags.

Alex's Goals

- Wants an easy-to-use tracker that will quickly alert him if his dogs are outside a certain perimeter.
- Wants an immediate way to connect and reach out to pet owners in the area to help locate his missing dogs.
- Wants to know the most efficient way to find missing pets as soon as possible. Clues to where they've been would be essential in finding them as soon as possible. Time is key.

Sandra had 3 small dogs in the past who passed away due to old age. She has 1 cat who is independent and loves to play with her neighbor's kids. She lives on the ground level of an apartment building. Sometimes, she worries that the neighbor's kids might accidentally let him out of her apartment unit by accident. She also worries about him being cat-napped or attacked by other animals if he really gets out of the apartment building.

Sandra's Goals

- Wants an easy-to-use tracker that's reliable that can sync with her new iPhone.
- Wants an easy and fast way to create "Missing Pets" flyers/posters
- Wants to immediately contact anyone in her community who may be able to help search for her missing cat.

I adore my cats and I want them happy and safe

Profile: 35 years old, lives very close to Milan, but in a nice residential area. Engaged with Giorgio (bar owner, same age) but living on her own, no kids.



Carolina works as a consultant in the water treatment field. She's got a good balance between a good job and her private life.

She's got 3 cats she adores, and she considers them almost as her kids. Her cats go around alone, even if they usually stay in the surroundings. The area is relatively quiet but you can never know...

She has never lost a cat, but a friend lost hers, and was devastated. Carolina tried to help her via Facebook, Whatsapp, friends and acquaintances, but with no results. Maybe the cat had been killed or catnapped.

Carolina was very sorry for her friend, and she is worried that the same can happen to her cats. They know the way home, but she's afraid they can be run over by a car or get attacked by other animals or evil people, or stolen. They are chipped but the microchip doesn't locate the animal: it requires someone kind finding the cat and taking it to a vet or pets shelter for identification. And many people think only dogs have to be chipped, so the probably won't do it.

She would be definitely interested in something that could locate the pet, not only if it gets lost, but above all if it gets hurt or captured, and cannot come home on its own.

Tech savviness: Carolina is fairly tech-savvy and she's been using computers since school time. She uses a laptop as a support in her job, and at home for internet search, Facebook and activities such as archiving pics, archiving and managing files...

She can easily use and learn new devices, she has an iPhone, an iPad, a GPS in her car, a device to measure her sport performances and track her path when she goes running....

Carolina's Goals

Being always able to precisely locate the cats, knowing whether they are ok or whether they need help, and get timely and clear directions to reach them in case.

CREATION OF PERSONAS

Persona 1: Thomas



Context: Thomas is a 32 year old married with children. As an Account Manager who is very busy at weekdays, he reserves Saturday early afternoon for going to the supermarket, taking his kid with him.

Quotation: *“Doing groceries for the week with a little kid is impossible without a list, as I have to make sure I don’t forget anything.”*

Having a busy job and a little kid to take care of, Thomas has a lot on his mind. His wife draws up a list of groceries which gladly assists Thomas in not forgetting anything critical from the supermarket. If they have any coupons for products on the list, he will take them with him and use them.

While shopping, he keeps an eye on his child, sometimes crying for attention and distracting him from his job. Thomas sometimes buys things that are not on the list, to keep his child happy or because they are in discount. It regularly occurs that Thomas notices at the checkout that he has forgotten something mentioned on the list, having to go back.

Background:

Narrative:

Bunmi is a busy mum that has a regular need to shop for her family needs. This she has broken into one heavy shopping every month and other minor ones as the need arises. Having young children to care for, she often shops with them.

She:

- Goes to Store with a list of her household/personal needs (list can be

memorized, written on paper or in a mobile App)

- Locates these items in the store by searching through labels on the shelves in different section/departments
- Uses Trolley (one or more) while shopping to carry her items more conveniently

She may call home for help to remember what's needed if she forgets, call friends when she needs help in locating items in the local. Also, she requests for assistance from the store staff when she can't locate specific thing she believes is in the store or new to that particular store.

She shops in the morning hours or weekdays rather than evening hours and weekends to avoid delays in checking out from the store.

She reads store handbooks or local publications to hunt for coupons or sales promo
